Project Updates

- **Harry Wurzbach/Stanley Rd Intersection:** Working on pedestrian islands and installation of exterior traffic light pole. Traffic study to program traffic light sequence started week of 5 Nov 2012. ECD 18 Jan 2013.
- **Scott Rd VCC:** Contractor installing chicken wire to the interior walls for AT/FP compliance. ECD 28 Feb 2013.
- **Binz-Engleman ECP:** Project awarded 30 Sep 2012 to construct an Entry Control Point (ECP) at Binz-Engleman Road. Contractor has started design.
- **Construct Marquees:** Project provides marquees in the vicinity of the Wilson Way, Walters St, and Harry Wurzbach ECP's to display upcoming events, exercise messages, etc. Notice To Proceed pending. ECD 28 Jul 2013.

Project Updates (cont'd)

- **New Braunfels Gate:** Project repairs/replaces damaged sections of existing inbound and outbound wrought iron gate and installs removable pipe bollards. Bonds in review. NTP should be issued o/a 14 Dec 2012. ECD 29 Mar 2013.
- **Sidewalks:** Project will repair/replace sections of damaged sidewalk on west end of Stanley Road in the 100 area. Project will also install new sidewalk from McWethy Troop Medical Clinic to Wilson Way along the west side of Garden Rd. NTP is pending. ECD 7 Aug 2013.
- **Bldg 2265 Chillers:** Project updates controls and electrical components for the existing two chillers in the basement of bldg 2265. These chillers serve Bldgs 2263, 2264, 2265, and 2266. Once complete, chillers will be able to run at full rated capacity. Project started 17 Aug 2012. ECD 11 Jan 2013.

- **Replace Roof, Bldg 1222 (Campbell Library):** Estimated construction start 15 Dec 2012. ECD 28 Feb 2013.
- **Repair Roofs, Bldgs 5105, 5106, 5107 & 5124 (Camp Bullis DFAC's):** Estimated constructions start 3 Dec 2012. ECD 1 Feb 2013.
- **Repair Roof, Bldg 367 (In/Out Processing):** Passed pre-final inspection 30 Nov 12. Contractor completed construction, but a minor unforeseen leak was found outside the current contract scope. 502 CES is working to temporarily repair; permanent repair will be done by contract modification. Current ECD 5 Jan 2013, but will likely be extended by modification.
- **Replace Roof, Bldg 366 (Barber Shop, etc):** Estimated construction start 15 Dec 2012. ECD 15 Feb 2013.
- **Replace Roof, Bldg 5900 (Camp Bullis Theater):** Construction Notice To Proceed and ECD pending. Currently awaiting submittals.
- **Repair Roof, Bldg 320 (Jimmy Brought Fitness Center):** Construction started 18 Sep 2012. ECD 16 Jan 2013.

Christmas Tree Safety

- Choose a tree with fresh, green needles that do not fall off when touched.
- Before placing the tree in the stand, cut 1–2” from the base of the trunk.
- Make sure the tree is at least three feet away from any heat source, like fireplaces, radiators, candles, heat vents or lights.
- Make sure the tree is not blocking an exit.
- Add water to the tree stand. Be sure to add water daily.
- Use lights that have the label of an independent testing laboratory. Some lights are only for indoor or outdoor use.
- Replace any string of lights with worn or broken cords or loose bulb connections. Connect no more than three strands of mini string sets and a maximum of 50 bulbs for screw-in bulbs. Read manufacturer’s instructions for number of LED strands to connect.
- Never use lit candles to decorate the tree.
- Always turn off Christmas tree lights before leaving home or going to bed.

Fire Extinguishers Approaching Out of Service Date

- Many fire extinguishers on Joint Base San Antonio are due maintenance before 01 Jan 2013. NFPA 10 requires extinguishers receive certified maintenance every six years.
- Check to see if you have extinguishers manufactured in the year 2006 or earlier. These extinguishers require maintenance.


