


Walters Street Entry Control Point

- Awarded 15 Jul 10 to Greenleaf Construction Inc. (HUBZone Small Business) for \$9,839,658.
- 48% complete. BOD June 2012.
- Provides completely new Entry Control Point including:
 - ID check area with canopy and overwatch gatehouse
 - Visitor Control Center and parking
 - Commercial and passenger vehicle search area with canopy and office
 - Approach, entry control, and response zone paving
 - Utility and infrastructure improvements
 - Passive and active vehicle barriers
- Ongoing work includes building walls, installing curbs, and installing passive barriers. CPS to shortly start moving overhead electric lines.
- Future temporary closures of Wilson Way and Scott Rd being planned to install final denial barriers. Future detours required to construct Scott Rd. Dates and detours will be published when finalized. Detours will cause inconvenience and delays at the gate.

TRAINING

Due to current drought conditions and the potential for wildfires, the use of pyrotechnics at Camp Bullis and TA 10A/10B FSH is banned for the next 60 days (10 Nov 11) or until weather condition improved significantly. **This ban extends to the use of pyrotechnics in fire pits and barrels.** Decision to lift the ban will be made in coordination with the Fire Chief.
